Application to hold the National PHA Medal Class

The National PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class is open to riders under 18 years of age. Riders do not have to be members of the PHA to ride in this class. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences at a recommended height of 3'6". Course to include at least one combination including an oxer and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge may insert two tests into the original course (USEF Test 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is at the discretion of the judge. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class three (3) riders must complete the course. Points won in this class are as follows: With up to 15 riders, points will count 10-6-4-2-1- 1/2 in order for first to sixth place. With 16-30 riders points will count double and with 31 or more riders points will count triple. Based on these points there will be a championship finals for the top 30 riders based on accumulated points over the season. The season runs one year from August 16<sup>th</sup> to the following August 15<sup>th</sup> with a championship finals traditionally held in September. Riders who lose their junior status at the end of the USEF show year are not eligible to compete in the PHA medal class after August 15<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the Championship Finals is not eligible to ride in future PHA Medal Classes. This class may be combined with another Medal Class with equal specifications.

There is no pre-payment to hold the National PHA Medal Class. At the conclusion of the class every show will withhold ten dollars (\$10.00) for every entry as long as a minimum of 3 riders compete the course. The results for the class must be sent via email electronically to Scott Tarter at Scott@TwinLakesFarm.com within 10 business days in order for points to count and be posted to the website. The results are submitted using the exact same file emailed to the USEF in the shownumber.dat format, just copy Scott on email to USEF. No other formats will be accepted. Rider's points will be posted regularly at www.NationalPHA.com. Class sheets along with a check representing ten dollars (\$10.00) per rider entered in the PHA Medal Class, whether or not they completed the course must be mailed to Mrs. Helen Bilby, 968C Heritage Hills, Somers, NY 10589. The check must be made payable to PHA, Inc. and include every riders name and home address listed on the class sheet. Failure to comply with any of the above will void the class along with any points awarded to any riders in the class. If the class fails to fill please return class sheets marked "did not fill". All results sheets must be signed.
