

## APPLICATION TO HOLD THE NATIONAL PHA MEDAL CLASS

The National PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class is open to riders under 18 years of age. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences at 3'6" in height, with at least one combination including an oxer, and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge will insert two tests into the original course (USEF Tests 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is optional. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course. Points won in this class are as follows: With up to 15 riders, points will count 10-6-4-2-1-1/2; with 16 to 30 riders, points will count double and with 31 riders and above, points will count triple. Based on these points there will be a championship class for the 45 riders who have accumulated the most points throughout the season to be held at a horse show selected by the National PHA. The season runs from August 16<sup>th</sup> and ends the following August 15<sup>th</sup>. Riders who lose their junior status at the end of the year are NOT eligible to compete in the PHA Medal Class after August 15<sup>th</sup>. The winner of the championship is NOT eligible to ride in future PHA Medal classes. For permission to offer this class at recognized shows only, please contact Mrs. H. O. Bilby at 914-276-0348 after 7PM. Application to hold the PHA Medal class must be made in writing prior to the horse show.

There is no prepayment required to hold the class. However, every show will withhold \$10.00 for every entry as long as 6 riders complete the course. The results for the class must be sent within 10 days to Scott Tartar at [scott@twinlakesfarm.com](mailto:scott@twinlakesfarm.com). The same file electronically submitted to the USEF must be used. Rider's point totals will be available on the National PHA website at [www.nationalpha.com](http://www.nationalpha.com) and will be updated on a regular basis. Class sheets along with a check representing \$10.00 for every rider entered in the PHA class whether or not they completed the course as long as that class had 6 or more riders complete the course is to be sent within 10 days of the horse show to: Mrs. H. O. Bilby, 968C Heritage Hills, Somers, NY 10589. Every rider's home address must be listed on the class sheets. Failure to comply with the above will void the class along with any points won by any riders in the class. If the class does not fill, return the class sheets marked Did Not Fill. All result sheets must be signed.
