

NATIONAL PHA MEDAL HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION CLASS
SPECIFICATIONS

The National PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class is open to riders under 18 years of age. To be shown over a course of eight or more fences at 3'6" in height, with at least one combination including an oxer and two changes of lead after the first fence. The judge will insert two tests into the original course (USEF Tests 1-18). Further testing of the top riders is optional. Only one rider per horse. To fill a class, six competitors must complete the course. Points won in this class are as follows: With up to 15 horses, points will count 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. With 16 to 30 riders points will count double and 31 riders and above, points will count triple. All classes with 50 or more entries at the beginning of the class must be divided and run as two separate classes with separate trophies and ribbons. (EQ 103-3A) Based on these points there will be a Championship ride-off class for the 30 riders who have accumulated the most points throughout the year, at a horse show to be selected by the National PHA. The season each year begins August 16th and ends August 15th of the following year. Riders who will lose their Junior status at the end of the year are NOT eligible to compete in the PHA Medal class after August 15th. The winner of the championship ride-off class is NOT eligible to ride in future PHA Medal classes. For permission to offer this class please contact Mrs. H. O. INFORMATION FOR HOLDING THE PHA MEDAL CLASS

PERMISSION: Applications to hold the PHA Medal Hunter Seat Equitation Class must be made in writing prior to the horse show. Only recognized horse shows may offer this class.

REMUNERATION: There is no prepayment required to hold the class. However, every show with withhold \$10.00 for every entry as long as 6 riders complete the course, and send it to the PHA. Included with your check MUST be a copy the PHA Medal Class sheet. This check and class sheet MUST be returned (postmarked) to the PHA within 10 days after the conclusion of the horse show. Every rider's name and HOME ADDRESS MUST BE LISTED on the class sheet. Failure to comply with the above will void the class along with any points won by any riders in the class. If the class does NOT fill, return the class sheet marked DID NOT FILL.
